How we use cookies on our website

We use cookies and similar tools across our websites to improve their performance and enhance your user experience. This policy explains how we do that.

What are cookies and how do we use them?

Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you first visit a site or page. The cookie will help the website, or another website, to recognise your device the next time you visit. We use the term "cookies" in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this way.

We utilise cookies to analyse how our visitors use our websites and to monitor website performance. This allows us to quickly identify and fix any issues that arise. For example, we might use performance cookies to keep track of which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, and to determine why some pages are receiving error messages.

We also use functionality cookies to provide you with enhanced services such as allowing you to watch a video online.

We use cookies for analytics. We like to keep track of, for example, what information and links are popular and which ones do not get used as much. Analytics cookies are used to gather this information. These 'analytics' cookies are used to improve how a website and its pages work.

We use or allow third parties to serve cookies to help us monitor our website traffic. We may also use third party cookies to help us with market research, improving site functionality and monitoring compliance with our terms and conditions policy.

Accept or block cookies in your browser settings

You can block any cookies from any website by changing the setting in your browser that allows you to refuse some or all cookies (including strictly necessary cookies). If you do choose to block all cookies, you may not be able to access some or all our website, and you may find that your ability to enjoy the site is negatively affected.
